### 3. GUEST LIST

STAKE will have the opportunity to have 10 persons on the guest list. We will provide the organizer with a list at the day of the concert. If there is a need to be provided with the guest list in advance, please reach out to the management.

### 4. MERCHANDISE

The organizer provides a suitable place with table and light where the merchandise can be sold. For this, no commission is paid to the organisation.

For festival merchandise, make sure there is a permanent control on the merchandise booth.

### 5. ROOM

It would be great if you could provide us with a lockable dressing room for at least 10 people with table, chairs, fridge and preferably some couches. No lockouts please!

### 6. HOSPITALITY & CATERING

### WHAT WE DRINK

- · Tea and coffee!
- Plenty of cooled mineral water (sparkling + still)
- 3 big bottles or 12 cans of Coca-Cola
- 3 big bottles or 12 cans of Fanta
- 6 bottles / cans of Aquarius (you can pick the colour yourself)
- 12 cans of Nalu Energy Drink

PS: We're really not an unreasonable or fussy band and if anything above proves difficult to be provided, please don't hesitate to contact us, so we can come to an alternative arrangement.



### 3. PA SPECS

Please provide:

- A min. 24 channels FOH desk, 8 subgroups !!!
- 6 channels of gating, 8 channels of compression, a 31 bands graphic stereo EQ inserted over the L&R output. 1 DDL (SDE3000/D-Two), 2 Multi FX (M3000/SPX)

### 4. MONITORS

Please provide:

- A min. 24 channels MON desk + one experienced monitor engineer.
- 4 separate monitor sends/ 31-band EQ's inserted on each monitor send.
- SEND 1: (Cis Gtr) 2 wedges
- SEND 2: (Brent Lead Voc/Gtr) 2 wedges
- SEND 3: (Jesse Bass) 2 wedges
- SEND 4: (Joris Drums) 1 drumfill !!!!

### 5. STAGE AND POWER SUPPLY

- Backline power supply should be a stable, earthed 240VAC.
- Please provide a stable riser 3mx2m / 20-40cm high for drums

### 6. BACKDROP

• Please provide a truss or flybar at the back of the stage, covering the complete width of the stage. Backdrop dimensions max. 10mx8m

### **Additional Conditions**

- 1. We would love to have a clean, warm, lockable space close to the stage to prepare the show. This space is available for band and crew.
- 2. We'll play our best shows on a solid stage with minimum dimensions as asked in the attached technical rider. If backline or gear by other bands or crews is taking place on stage, this should be discussed with the band or manager at least 2 hours before the show.
- 3. At outdoor shows the stage must be fully covered and safe for wind, rain or storm. Just to protect our backline, thank you. Also, we would like to have a closed and dry, waterproof space, close to the stage, to prepare our backline, amps, guitars, drums... The decision to play or not play in dangerous circumstances (storm, water...) is made only by the band and/or their manager.
- 4. The stage cannot have other backdrops or projections behind the band. Before, during or after the show entrance to the stage is controlled by the band and crew. The room lights must be turned off during the performance. The promoter ensures the security of the band during the show.
- 5. The promoter has to provide a clean and free space to sell band merchandising. Two tables, chairs, a good accessible place and power outlet would be awesome. If there is a WIFI-network available, it would be cool to have some access to it. We promise not to kill your download limit and to keep it clean. And safe.
- 6. Without written permission of the artist, it is not allowed to make audio/visual recordings of the concert. Any unlawful use of this recording will be prosecuted.
- 7. The artist has the right, in case of a TV-show, studio-recordings or a foreign assignment, to reschedule the concert in consultation with the promoter. This may in no circumstances give rise to compensation.
- 8. All costs related to organizing this concert, including publicity, taxes, copyright, license, to do, operating expenses, excise etc. are the sole responsibility of the organizer. The organizer is also responsible for attending all required permits and may in its absence does not rely on force majeure.
- 9. Every damage or theft made and/or caused by audience and/or promotor (and contributors) to instrument and related material of the artist is fully reimbursed by the promoter against appraisal values of the material. This amount can be claimed the same evening.
- 10. In case of force majeure (illness, accident, car breakdown...) the artist and/or Busker will notify the promotor as soon as possible. If we need to cancel the concert, Busker is first given the opportunity to present an alternative.
- 11. In case the public and/or promotor, before/during/after the performance profiling racist, fascist or discriminatory has the right to stop the concert and the artist will still receive the agreed fee.
- 12. The promotor confirm she/he is an adult, She/he is not an intermediary and takes full responsibility.
